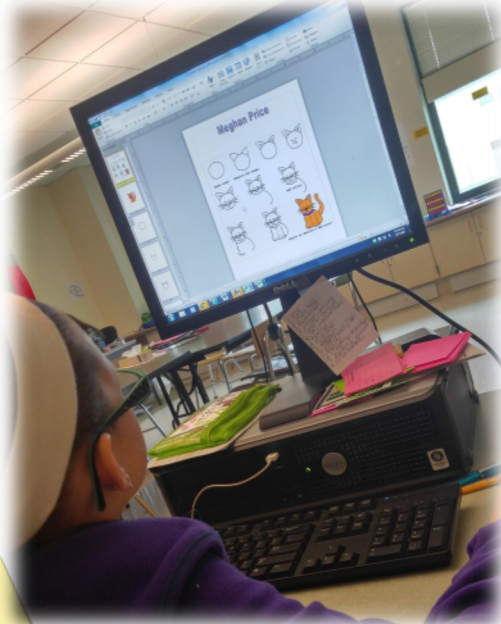


## We're Proud Of RRMS Student Meghan Price!

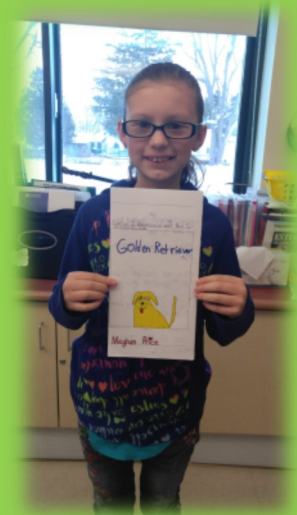
